The Cork Story

Cork is the bark of an oak tree known as Quercus suber. It grows naturally along the Mediterranean Sea. Portugal is the world's largest producer of cork products. With its remarkably unique characteristics, cork has had many uses throughout the ages - by the ancient Greeks for making wine stoppers and later by the Romans for container stoppers. Cork can be found in the soles of shoes, in the heat shield of the US space shuttle. The main products generated from cork today are wine stoppers, underlayment and flooring.

Cork is a completely renewable resource. Bark that is stripped from the cork oak tree will regenerate itself every nine years for continuous harvesting for upwards of 150 years. One cubic foot of cork contains more than 200 million completely enclosed air cells. This unique structure is what makes cork an exceptional flooring product. Cork is comfortable, quiet and warm underfoot. It is hypoallergenic, resilient and extremely durable. Because cork is beautiful, easy to care for and 100% natural - making it an ideal flooring choice for any room.
